





Nursery – Learning Intention Overview

| | Wednesday | Thursday | Friday |
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| Phonics 10 minutes | Have a look around the room that you are in. What can you see? Can you play I spy with your grown up and see if they can guess what you can see. Can you hear the sound that the word begins with? (e.g I spy with my little eye something that begins S. ssssssssss, Sofa!) You may need some help from your grown up to hear the initial sound. | Voice sounds- sheet attached. Can you moo like a cow? Baaaa like a sheep. See if you can work through the activities together. | Can you sing some nursery rhymes? Baa baa black sheep, Incy Wincy spider, Old McDonald had a farm. Which one is your favourite? Can you join in with the actions? |
| Maths 10 minutes | Can you count to 10? Can you count slowly and then count quickly? Can you whisper your number and then shout them really loudly? | Do you know your shapes? Rectangle circle square triangle  How many sides do they have and how many corners? Can you count them? | Can you line up some items in your house and use your finger to touch count them? Can you carefully count each one? |
| Story session 10 minutes | Click on the book to see Mrs Edwards reading 'The colour monster goes to school' by Anna Llenas  What do you like doing best at Nursery? | Click on the Gruffalo to watch Mrs Edwards reading 'The Gruffalo' by Julia Donaldson  The BBC have added the Gruffalo film if you would like to watch it https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episodes/b00pk64x/the-gruffalo I love the rhyming parts in this book.
