Black school shoes are required. This consists of tracksuit, t shirt and trainers (which your child is able to put on and take off themselves)</p>

Please speak to the member of staff on the gate each morning or at the end of the session. All children with asthma will need two named inhalers and a spacer in school. A care plan will be created with you by a member of staff.</p>

## How does learning take place in Nursery?

Your child will learn through structured play and some more formal, short learning sessions.

Children are given lots of opportunities to work and explore independently as well as working in groups with their teachers and with friends. Your child will have chance to learn indoors and out every day.

## How can I support my child when they are at school?

One of the best ways to support your child at home is through reading and sharing stories. Talking to your child is key and each week we will send home 'Nursery Weekly News' to update you on what we will be learning next week and how you can help.



## How can I help my child to be 'school ready'?

Talk to your child about how exciting school will be and that it is okay to feel a little nervous to start with! Please help them to be as independent as possible to learn how to do the following:

- Put on and take off their school shoes and socks
- Put their coat on and fasten it
- Learn how to get dressed and undressed ready for PE
- Say please and thank you
- Play turn taking games and learn to tidy away
- Go to the toilet independently and wash their hands with soap
