This had him thinking and Mr Tickle was invented! The Mr Men books and Little Miss Books have continued to be popular to this day. There are some special coins being made this year to celebrate the 50th anniversary, all designed by Roger's son Adam. We have been looking at these books as part of our animation topic.
