To find equivalent fractions (Day 2)

Today pupils will continue looking at equivalent fractions. If they did not complete the lesson on 12.02.21 they may want to go back and complete that first.

Pupils may find it helpful to use some of the virtual maths resources for fractions which can be found in the content library. There is also a fraction wall in the maths content library.

Today pupils will begin to move away from using the fraction wall and start using their knowledge of multiplying and dividing. If they are finding this difficult, they can continue to use the fraction wall (which is available in the maths contents library). Again, if they have missed the lessons on 12.02.21 and 22.02.21 they should do these first.

To be able to simplify fractions

Today pupils will be looking at simplifying fractions using their knowledge of division and factors. If they find today's task tricky it may help to use the multiplication square in the maths content library to help identify common factors.
