Lateness

Children should be entering through their year group entrance. Doors do not close until 8.55am and children should not be brought to the office before this time. This is an extremely busy time for office staff and if doors are still open you will be asked to walk around to your child's entrance.

If the school should be unable to open because of an emergency or bad weather, the school will send a text message to parents as early as possible.

As always we will do our best to keep the school open; any decision to close will be made as early as possible to give parents and carers the opportunity to make alternative childcare arrangements.

Celebration Assembly

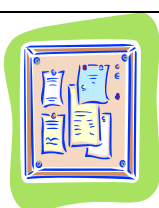
Many thanks to all of the parents who shared our Celebration Assembly with us. It was great to see so many of you in school.
