SATs

Our Year Six children will be sitting their end of Key Stage Two SATs throughout next week, week commencing 13th May.

The tests are statutory, externally set and externally marked.

Please ensure that all children are in school on time throughout the week.

The tests are important for the children and the school. We hope that all of our pupils do as well as they can. Our Year Two children will also continue to take part in their Key Stage One assessments during the next two weeks.

To achieve their very best this we recommend that all pupils (not just Y6) follow these simple rules:



Get some sleep! At least 8 hours per night.

Make sure that you have breakfast.



Think about what you have for lunch and try to make it a healthy option.

Make sure that your brain has fuel! Drink plenty of water every day – bring use and refill your water bottle.



Don't worry! Our children have worked very hard this year and they should feel confident about the coming assessments. We are very proud of all of them.

Special Circumstances

Unfortunately it is sometimes the case that children sitting external tests such as the end of KS2 SATs experience particular trauma etc in the lead up to, or during the tests. Such circumstances might be acute illness, bereavement, domestic upheaval, problems at home etc. In such cases we can report this to the National Assessment Agency (leaving out sensitive/confidential information), and special consideration may be given to the child in the event of him/her missing a particular level by a few marks. **Please advise us of any circumstances that you feel may adversely affect your child for the SATs or other aspects of school life.**
