## School Picnic Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July

### Arrangements

We are really looking forward to the school picnic and hope that everybody has a great time – we've got our fingers crossed for dry weather!

#### **CHILDREN ARE WELCOME TO COME TO SCHOOL IN SPORTS WEAR**

**Please note that there will not be any school dinners available on the day of the picnic; children who normally receive a Free School Meal/ Universal Free School Meals will be provided with a bottle of water and a piece of fruit, any sandwich orders needed to have been received in school by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June, along with any full packed lunch orders for pupils who are not in receipt of free school meals. (Obviously parents/carers can provide an alternative/additional packed lunch for their children if they wish.)**

I apologise for the amount of information that follows, but it is necessary to ensure that everybody has a good time, and that our children are safe.

- The picnic will begin at **12.30 PM**

### **Outdoor Event**

- Parents/friends/family will enter the school grounds through the **Green Heath Road** pedestrian access.
- The red gate by the **Key Stage One Playground** will be *manned* by a member of the school staff with a radio at all times.
- The red gate by the **Key Stage One Playground** will be locked throughout the afternoon, and only opened to allow visitors to enter/leave the school grounds
- No children will be allowed through the gate, even with a parent/adult, without the verbal permission of **Miss Tonkinson** or **Mrs Yates**.
- The gate into the **EYFS Outdoor Learning Area** will be kept locked at all times.

- The pedestrian access gate on **Rose Hill** will remain locked until the end of the school day.
- Parents/friends/family who arrive at the school's reception will be redirected back through the pedestrian gate to re-enter the school grounds through the **Green Heath Road** pedestrian access
- Parents are welcome to bring chairs, hampers etc if they wish
- Children will be led out onto the field by their classteachers at 12.30pm. Please note the red KS1 gate onto the field, **will not be opened** before the children are all safely on the field with their teachers.
- Reception children will access the school field through the **Key Stage One cloakroom doors**
- **All Nursery** children will arrive at the picnic at 12.30pm with a parent/family member. Any Nursery child whose family are **not** staying with them, **MUST** find **Mrs Downing/Mrs Shaw** and hand their child over to them with their lunch. These children will need to be collected at 2.30pm
- The children will sit down together on the field as a class group
- Parents/carers/family members can collect their children from classteachers
- Classteachers will tick each child off their list as he/she is collected by a parent
- Parents/carers and children can remain with the class group, or sit with other friends/family members from other classes.
- Play equipment and balls will be available on the field for the children and adults to play with.
- Parents/carers and children are invited to bring safe outdoor games from home if they wish; *Swingball, Frisbees , Aerobeas etc.*
- Icecream vans will be present on the field throughout the afternoon
- Rubbish should, wherever possible, be put back into the children's lunchbox
- Each class will have a black bin bag for any additional rubbish
- Parents/family member will be able to leave at any point during the afternoon through the **Green Heath Road** pedestrian access
- If parents/family members leave the school premises before the end of the picnic, children must be returned directly to the classteacher

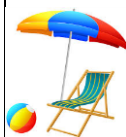
- Teachers will place a tick in the second column of their picnic register to indicate that a child has been returned to them.
- All children should remain at school until 2.30pm when the picnic finishes. Children are *not* permitted to leave before this time unless there are exceptional circumstances which have been agreed beforehand by Miss Tonkinson.
- Children must be signed out by their class teachers at the end of the picnic before leaving.
- Staff will be lined up by the red gate by the **Key Stage One Playground** to sign children out at 2.30pm.
- All other children who cannot leave with a family member at 2.30pm will remain in school until the normal end of the school day.

### **Nursery**

- **Morning Nursery** session is closed on this day and all Nursery children should arrive for 12.30pm with their lunch.
- Parents/carers should make their way from the Green Heath Road pedestrian gate to the red gate on the KS1 playground, where a member of the nursery staff will collect children whose parents/carers will not be staying for the picnic.
- Parents/carers who are staying for the picnic with their children will be invited to enter the grounds together.
- Unaccompanied Nursery children will be supervised by school staff.

### **Wet Weather Arrangements**

- Due to the exceptionally large number of people who attend this event it will **NOT** be possible to relocate it indoors in the event of wet weather.
- The school will make a decision as to whether the event will go ahead as soon as possible.
- Any cancellation will be notified by **text message** and **banner on school website**
- **It will be the responsibility of parents/carers to inform relatives/additional adults of any cancellation**
- In the event of cancellation children would eat their picnic lunch within the school building
- If there is any risk of cancellation, parents/carers should ensure that children have their own packed lunch with them in school.

To save time at the ticket sales please complete a slip and bring it with you. Spare Slips are available from the school office All tickets are on a first come, first served basis.

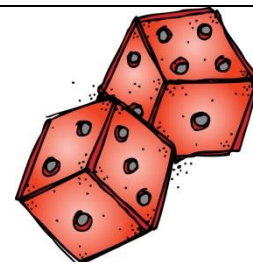
## **SUN SAFETY**
