#### **Bromcom – Email Problems**




During the week, we have been having major problems with our email system. Our provider, Bromcom, are aware of the problem and are working to rectify the problem.

## Benefits Related Free School Meals – Pupil Premium

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

If you child already gets Free School Meals/Pupil Premium (you will have received holiday food vouchers if you are already registered) then you do not need to complete the form.

Please do not confuse this with Universal Infant Free School Meals, as ALL pupils in Reception, Y1 and Y2 get a free meal at school. This is something separate.
