


Online Safety

Many apps, including WhatsApp, Tiktok and Snapchat do have a **minimum age of 13 years old** to be able to sign up, which means that no children within our school should really be using this.

Mr Nugent, our Computing Lead, and I are also going to deliver sessions to pupils with regards to this.


