I hope you have all had a lovely break spending quality time with family and friends.

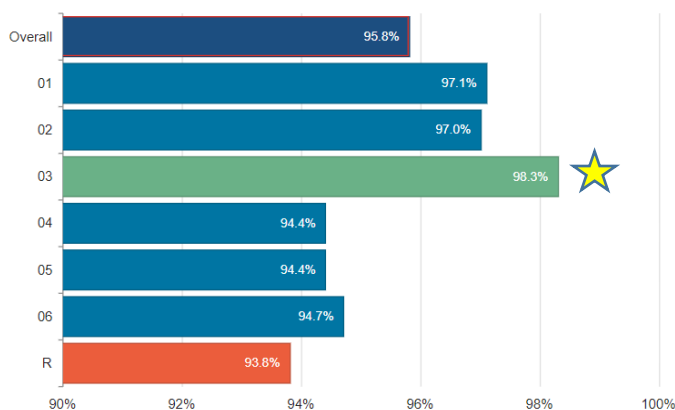

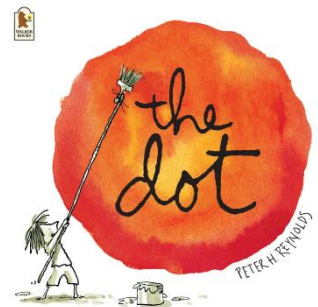
