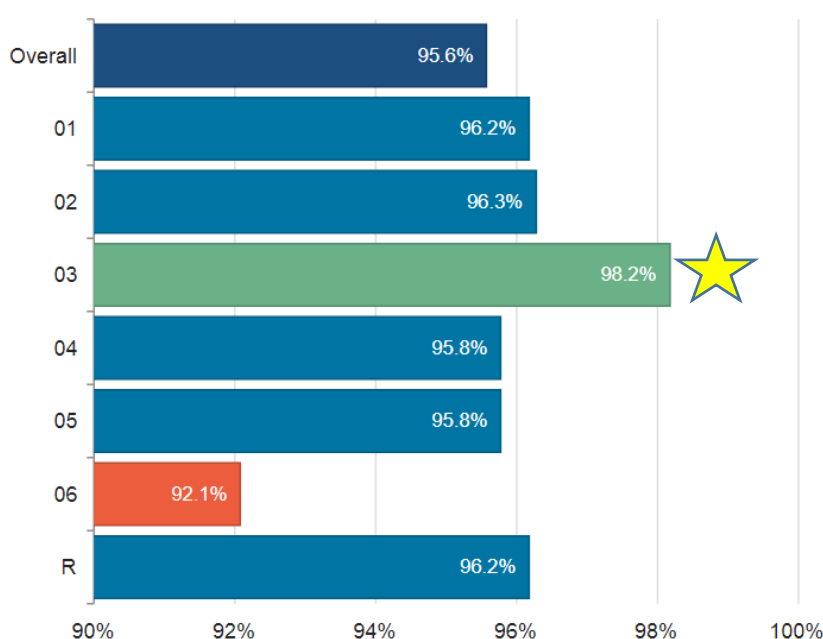

Parents, please be aware the £3.00 cost of the parent meal must be paid for in full before we can serve the meal. This should be paid on My Child at School (MCAS).

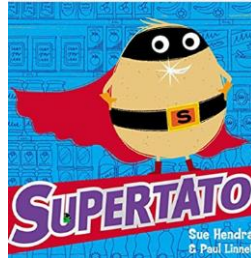

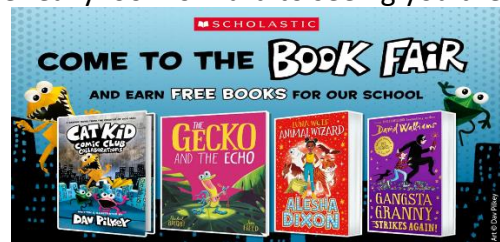
Scholastic Book fair- Monday 20th March- Thursday 23rd March

Message from TREAD

Please find below information from TREAD, the theatre company who produced the pantomime our children saw in December.

We are delighted to inform you that Tread Productions will be re-starting a new performing arts group in Cannock, starting after half term.

Over the past 15 years, Tread has developed into one of the UK's leading Theatre schools for young performers. Tread offers high quality training in the Performing Arts and students have enjoyed huge success within Television, Film and Theatre as a result of their commitment to Tread.



The weekly club will offer children the opportunity to work with professional actors every week in order to develop their performance skills. Classes have proven to develop self-confidence, communication and concentration skills amongst other vital performance techniques that can be used in their everyday life. The sessions are designed by Tread Directors and professional actors Helen Noble (Hollyoaks) & Graham Tudor (West End leading actor) & are delivered by members of their professional team. All of the actors hold valid DBS certificates and have extensive teaching experience with young children. The club will cost approximately £8 per session, further details and registration information will be forwarded from Tread.

Initially, we would like to offer children a chance to attend a free 'taster' session on Sunday 12th February from 4pm-5.30pm for 5-10 year olds and 6pm-7.30pm for 11-16 year olds. This will give your child an excellent opportunity to see if this is the club for them!
