






The Impact of Positive Words

Positive words strengthen areas in the brain that promote cognitive functioning and stimulate the motivational centres of the brain.

By holding a positive and optimistic thought in your mind, you stimulate frontal lobe activity. This area includes specific language centres that connect directly to the motor cortex responsible for moving you into action. Research has shown, the longer you concentrate on positive words, the more you begin to affect other areas of the brain.
