

This week saw our Year 6 pupils sit their SATs. We are so proud of how they all approached these tests. They were resilient, determined and gave it their all.







available at any time before this date.




Walk To School Week - 15-19 MAY 2023



Here are some mental health top tips: -


- Go out for a walk or a run.

Attendance

Congratulations to **Year 6** for having the best attendance during this week at a FANTASTIC **100%**. Overall school attendance stands at **96.4%** this week, which is perfectly in line with National average of

96.4%. Well done everyone, this is amazing 😂





Achieving 90% in an exam or test is a fantastic result, but if your child is at school for only 90% of the school year then they will have missed 19 days – this is almost four whole weeks of school and **100 hours** of missed learning.

Any child with attendance less than 90% is classed as being **persistently absent**.

Chase Creatures



The Eco-Committee and Art Ambassadors are very excited to tell you all about an exciting project they have been working on. The children helped design the Chase Creatures characters; these are based on the 12 messages of the Cannock Chase Code, which are simple messages to help protect Cannock Chase. You will be able to walk along the route and search for the Chase Creatures in a 'Pokémon Go' style game.

We now need help in testing out the challenge before it is available to the general public. As they are using cutting edge technology, they need to assess certain elements of the challenge such as phone coverage, signals, ease of collection etc. Any feedback you can give is greatly appreciated.

We hope you enjoy the challenge and learn more about how to look after Cannock Chase.

WHEN: Saturday 20th May 12 - 3pm

Where: Marquis Drive Visitor Centre - Cannock Chase Forest Hednesford - WS12 4PW

IMPORTANT - To undertake the Chase Creatures AR Test Challenge, you will need a smart phone with data, charged to at least 50% and if an iPhone it must be on version IOS 15.

How to access the challenge:

Before you visit the site:

- 1. Download the Cannock Chase Can App (available on Android/ IOS). Here's a short animation that shows you how, click here.
- 2. Set-up an account and answer your 'Wellness Wheel' questions.
- 3. The Chase Creatures Challenge can be found under the 'Move Well' section.
- 4. To access the challenge, you need to watch the introduction video on the Move Well section.
- 5. Once you have watched the video, you are ready to take on the challenge.
- 6. Please also read the feedback form provided, so you are aware of the information we would like to collect from our testers when completing the challenge.

On site:

- 1. Staff will be based at Marquis Drive Visitor Centre on the testing day. If you have any questions.
- 2. The challenge begins at the RAF Hednesford Commemoration Stone at Marquis Drive.
- 3. Open up the Cannock Chase Can App and return to the Move Well section.
- 4. Open up the Chase Creatures AR Trail and 'commit to challenge'
- 5. Press 'start collecting' and agree to the prompts that show on your screen.
- 6. You can use the map on the screen to see where the creatures are located. The creatures are located along a circular route that leads back to the café at Marquis Drive.
- 7. Use your phone to 'collect the creatures', there are 12 to collect.
- 8. You will not need to leave the pathway to collect the creatures.
- 9. Can you collect all 12!

After the challenge:

1. Please complete the feedback form (available at the Visitor Centre) and let us know what you thought of the challenge and your experience.



Uniform

Please ensure that your child is bringing the **correct kit to school for PE**. This should consist of a plain, coloured top of their house (red, blue, green or yellow) and dark shorts/tracksuit bottoms.
