

Attendance

Congratulations to **Year 5** for having the best attendance during this week with a fantastic **97%** Overall school attendance stands at **93.1%** this week, which is well below the National average.





Achieving 90% in an exam or test is a fantastic result, but if your child is at school for only 90% of the school year then they will have missed 19 days – this is almost four whole weeks of school and **100** hours of missed learning.

Any child with attendance less than 90% is classed as being persistently absent.

Meet The Teacher

This year, we will be holding our open evening in school on **Wednesday 12th July from 3.30 until 5.30pm**.

Sun Cream

We have recently enjoyed some lovely weather. Please ensure that children are well prepared for the sun. This includes sending pupils with a full water bottle every day, sending in hats and, if possible, applying sun cream before school.

The once-a-day sun cream is ideal as very few children enjoy having to be 'creamed up' and if it is therefore just once per day, all the better.

If you do want to send sun cream in for your child, a consent form will need to be completed - these can be collected from the office.

Each Year Group will repeat the session twice to try and support families with more than one child in school. You only need to attend one session for that year group.
