

Attendance

Congratulations to **Year 3** for having the best attendance during this week with a fantastic **96.5%**Overall school attendance stands at **94%** this week, which is an improvement on recent weeks – thank



Across school this term, <u>over a quarter of all absences (27.4%)</u> have been as a result of non-agreed term time holidays. Analysis of new Department for Education (DfE) data shows that 5,148,548 school days were lost due to "unauthorised term-time holidays" in the 2021/22 academic year.

Achieving 90% in an exam or test is a fantastic result, but if your child is at school for only 90% of the school year then they will have missed 19 days – this is almost four whole weeks of school and **100** hours of missed learning.

Any child with attendance less than 90% is classed as being **persistently absent**.
