

Attendance

Congratulations to **Year 1** for having the best attendance during this week with a fantastic **96.1%**Overall school attendance stands at **94.5%** this week, which is an improvement on recent weeks – thank



Across school this term, <u>over a quarter of all absences (27.4%)</u> have been as a result of non-agreed term time holidays. Analysis of new Department for Education (DfE) data shows that 5,148,548 school days were lost due to "unauthorised term-time holidays" in the 2021/22 academic year.

Next week, I am setting the target for **both** Year 2 and Year 5 to achieve attendance greater than 94%.

I also wonder if any other year groups can achieve over 96% attendance next week?

Today, we held our Celebration Assembly with Year 1, 2 and 3 coming together to share the successes of their classmates.





Staying Active at Pye Green

Over the weekend, Fun and Active Playgrounds visited school to install the 'Daily Mile' on the KS2 playground. On Monday, children immediately started using it on arrival at school and this has continued all week both at playtimes, lunchtimes and during PE.

The Daily Mile is an active trail for children comprising of a circuit of 11 times around the playground running, jumping, hopping and skipping their way to one third of their daily activity goal. For children, it can: -

- Improve fitness, including leg strength
- Contribute to improved alertness, mood and verbal memory
- Increase memory in the classroom and help children to concentrate
- Allow children to feel calmer after completing the mile
