Goodbye



Attendance For the WHOLE Year

Congratulations to both **Year 3 and Year 5** for having the best attendance during this academic year with attendance of **95.5**%

Overall school attendance stands for 2022/23 at 95%.





Children return to school on Wednesday 6th September. These first days back really matter. Evidence from a recent Children's Commissioner report showed that children who miss days 2, 3 and 4 of the new term for unauthorised reasons had a predicted overall absence of almost 45%, or 31 days across the term, compared to children who missed days near the end of term, with a predicted overall absence of 20-30%.

Whole School Non-Uniform

Tomorrow, **Friday 21st July** is our last day of term. All pupils are welcome to come to school in non-uniform.

New Logo and School Uniform

Across our 10 primary schools in the Greenheart Learning Partnership, we are rebranding for September with regards to logos and school signage. Our new logo, still incorporating our Pye Green tree, will be on new uniform available at Crested Schoolwear. The old logo on uniform is still fine to be used and for a time, therefore we will have a mix of both logos. 




From September, all pupils will also need to wear school PE kit. This consists of a plain red, blue, yellow or green t-shirt and dark shorts or jogging bottoms. The t-shirt colour represents the 'house' they are in. If pupils do not know which colour house they are in, they can ask class teachers. Pupils should not wear football or branded t-shirts. PE t-shirts do not need to have the school logo on.

Dinner Money Price Increase and School Debts

From September 6th (the start of the new term) Shire Services, who provide our school meals, are increasing their prices to £2.30 per pupil. Please ensure that all MCAS accounts are sufficiently credited. We are also aware that some families have increasing dinner money and Care Club debts. Mrs Snell has been contacting parents in recent weeks informing them of this and trying to arrange payment plans. Significant, unpaid debts will result in pupils in Key Stage 2 being unable to have school meals and Care Club places being withdrawn for the new term.

Please contact school as soon as possible to arrange for all debts to be cleared by 19/07/2023.
