
Attendance





With Christmas approaching quickly, we have many productions for the different year groups planned. The dates can all be found at the end of the newsletter in the 'upcoming events section'.


Please note, only 2 adults per family will be able to attend each production due to the space restrictions within school/church.


As in previous years, photography/videoing during the performances will not be possible.
