

### **Pupil Voice**

Before Christmas, all pupils completed a pupil learning and wellbeing survey. I have now received the results and I am delighted that pupils were overwhelmingly positive about Pye Green. Their results were above National average benchmarks for positive responses about behaviour, safeguarding, learning and curriculum.

Through the survey, some of our children shared that at times they experienced a range of emotions including, worry, sadness, loneliness and anger. After half term, all pupils in both KS1 and KS2 will be taking part in the Mental Health Champions Training Programme with the aim being to empower them to be mental health champions in school. During the remainder of the year, regular sessions will help them explore tools to achieve better emotional, physical and mental health as well as equip them with stress busting techniques and strategies to develop greater control of their emotions. Working alongside 'One Goal' we will work towards achieving CHAMPION outcomes.
