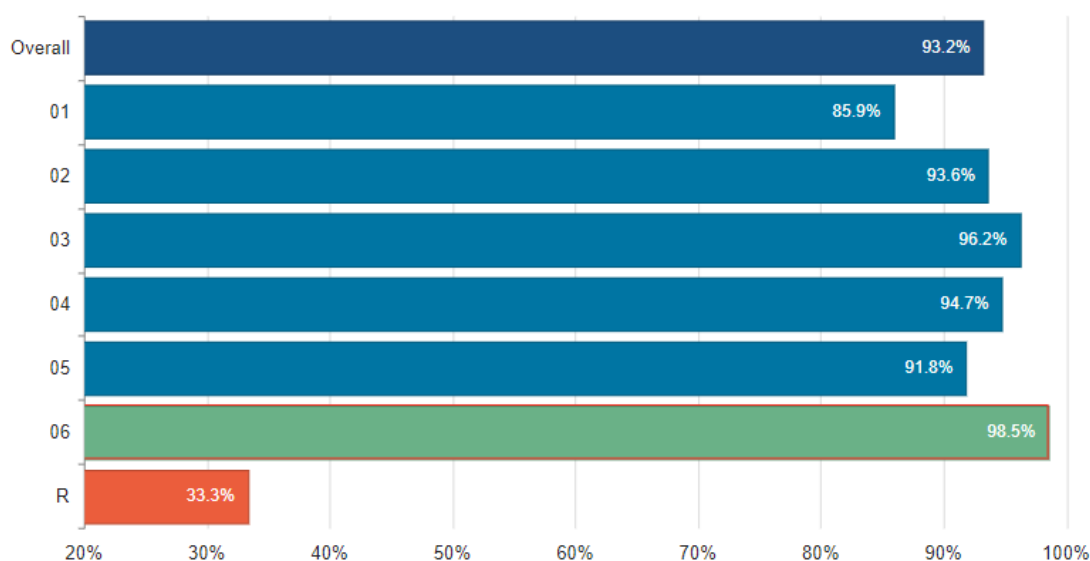
## Attendance
